BHAM has a fantastic selection of stallions in the BHAM Stallion Service Sale each year. SSS classes are offered during the Futurity for weanlings and yearlings from that sale. BHAM is consistently well represented at the ABRA World Show bringing home numerous national championships and top ten awards in addition to earning top honors in the National ABRA .Year End Award Standings.

This four judge, three and a half day event held each fall at the [MSU Pavilion](#) in East Lansing, Michigan draws exhibitors from all over the U.S. including Texas, Louisiana, Georgia, Florida, Virginia, West Virginia, Ohio, Kentucky, Indiana, Illinois, Missouri, Wisconsin, Minnesota, and Canada.

As the premier event hosted by BHAM, regular season Division and Saddle awards are presented during this time. In addition the Jr. BHAM Representative and Scholarship winners are also announced.
