JR. BHAM SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

In order to be eligible for the \$500.00 Jr. BHAM Scholarship awarded yearly by BHAM, you must meet and complete the following criteria:

- Be an active member of Jr. BHAM that shows in the ABRA Youth 14-18 or All Color Youth 14-18 Division the current year you are applying for the scholarship and must be eligible for the Jr. BHAM Year End Award.
- Attend and participate in 75% of the weekend BHAM shows of the current year.
- Have acquired at least a 3.0 (B) average or above for the year just completed in high school or higher learning.
- Write a 100-400 word essay that is double-spaced, Times New Roman, 12pt font, in response to the following question: How do you think your involvement with horses has helped prepare you for the challenges you will face as you become an adult and strive to achieve your chosen career goals?
- Complete the Jr. BHAM Scholarship Application and submit it along with your essay and a portrait (no larger than 8x10) of the applicant to the Jr. BHAM Director **on or before Monday, August 19th, 2019**.
- Attend a formal interview with the Jr. BHAM Scholarship Application Selection Committee; two questions will be given to the applicant in advance to prepare, and one question will be given only at the interview. The date will be announced and every effort made to accommodate the applicant's schedule.
- Volunteer at least 8 hours between April 1st, 2019 and August 15th, 2019. Upon the completion of the required hours, a Volunteer Review must be completed and signed by a person of authority reporting of your attitude and work ethic. This review must then be sent to the Jr. BHAM Scholarship Application Selection Committee by the person of authority completing the form and be postmarked no later than August 19th, 2019. Possible volunteer opportunities could include but are not limited to church mission projects, community services, Jr. BHAM service projects, help at a local food bank, help a handicapped riders association, volunteer at BHAM shows, etc.

Points are awarded for the following: application, essay, volunteer review/s, interview, and equally important, the observations of each applicant's conduct and character at BHAM shows and activities. Copies of each applicant's score sheets may be made available to them upon request after the Scholarship winner/s is determined. There can be more than one Scholarship winner.

Winner/s of the Jr. BHAM Scholarship will be announced at the All-American Buckskin Congress, which is sponsored by BHAM. Upon winning the scholarship, the funds shall be dispersed to the recipient made payable to the student **and** the University, College, or Trade School, at the time a Letter of Acceptance from said institution of higher learning is presented to the BHAM Treasurer on or before December 31st of the year of the scholarship winner's 19th birthday. If there is failure to produce said letter by the date specified, the funds are forfeited back to the Jr. BHAM Scholarship Fund.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION AND SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION MUST BE POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN MONDAY, AUGUST 19TH, 2019. Any application sent in postmarked AFTER this date will be discarded.
