Dress Code and Code of Conduct

Please always dress appropriately (Western Dress Attire) while performing BHAM Representative duties and/or obligations. Dress Attire does include ¾ length skirts, western hat with BHAM tiara, and the BHAM Representative sash.

Please be polite and kind to everyone, say Hello, and Smile, paying special attention to the children, when handing out Lead Line, or Walk Trot awards. Giving encouragement, being enthusiastic, and having a positive attitude to all is important in representing BHAM at shows and other associated events.

It is preferable for the BHAM Representative go abstain from smoking while she is in Queen Attire and performing duties as BHAM Representative. Intoxication and use of illegal drugs is not tolerated. Please keep all internet profiles clean and appropriate.

If candidate for BHAM Representative is found to have negatively written about BHAM or ABRA, she will be ineligible for the Representatives contest or mat be removed as BHAM Representative.

BHAM Board reserves the right to re-evaluate the status of the representative at any time during her reign as representative.
